Agricultural Land Value and Cash Rent Highlights

The United States farm real estate value, a measurement of the value of all land and buildings on farms, averaged \$4,170 per acre for 2024, up \$200 per acre from 2023. Alabama farm real estate values increased \$340 per acre and Florida values increased \$980 per acre. Farm real estate values in Georgia increased \$230 per acre and in South Carolina values increased \$140 per acre.

Cash rent paid to landlords for all cropland in the United States increased \$5.00 to \$160.00 per acre in 2024. Cash rent for pasture increased to \$15.50 per acre up \$0.50 from last year. In Alabama, cash rent for cropland averaged \$74.50 per acre, an increase of \$4.50 from last year. Cash rent for cropland in Florida increased \$5.00 to \$137.00 per acre. Georgia cash rent for cropland was up \$4.00 for 2024 at \$153.00 per acre. In South Carolina, cash rent for cropland decreased \$3.00 to \$53.00 per acre.
